

The Simcoe County District School Board (SCDSB) encourages facility partnership opportunities to share facilities to benefit students and the community as set out in SCDSB Policy 2345, Community Planning and Partnerships.

Offering space in schools to partners can reduce facility operating costs, improve services and supports to students and strengthen relationships between the school board, community partners and the public. Facility partnerships encourage and maximize the use of public infrastructure through increased flexibility and utilization, and provide a foundation for improved service delivery for communities. These partnerships allow the sharing of resources and facilities with community partners when building new schools, undertaking significant renovations and planning the use of unoccupied space in schools.

Community Planning and Partnerships Policy 2345 requires the board to identify facilities that may be suitable for partnerships with respect to unused space in schools, administrative buildings and new construction. There are currently no opportunities with respect to unused space in existing schools. Partnership opportunities will be considered for the following capital projects:
